## "RENEWER IF RELIGION" HADITH

The Prophet said: "Truly Allāh shall send forth for this Community, at the onset of every hundred years, someone / those who will renew for it <the status of> its Religion."

The scholars agreed, among them Abū Qilāba (d. 276) and Imām Ahmad, that the "Renewer" narration signified 'Umar ibn 'Abd al-'Azīz and then al-Shāfi'ī.<sup>2</sup>

Allah be well-pleased with them and grant us the baraka of their knowledge.
